



Call for papers

The international conference Nets4Workshop will be held in Colmar, France, from the 15th to the 17th may 2019. Themes covered by the conference cover Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) and communication technologies for vehicles on the road, rails and in the air. Each theme will be addressed in a dedicated session. Authors are invited to submit full anonymized papers comprising original works, not previously published, in English of max. 12 pages (or max. 8 pages for works in progress) in the LNCS single-column format.

Topics

Areas of interest of the workshop include (but are not limited to):

- vehicle-to-vehicle, vehicle-to-infrastructure communications,
- vehicle-to-Internet communications, Roadside infrastructure and core network,
- radio technologies for V2X,
- protocols for vehicular networks and performance enhancement,
- new trends in VANETS,
- mobility management, Network management, traffic modeling and optimization,
- trajectory optimization and trajectory and separation management,
- recent standardization efforts and problems (e.g. 802.11p, ITS G5, ERTMS, LTE-R),
- analytical, simulation, and experimental systems,
- cooperative ITS solutions, traveler information services and multi-modal transport,
- digital maps and localization using communication technologies and GNSS applications.

Accepted and presented technical papers will be published in the Springer Lecture Notes in Computer Science (LNCS) series.
